## **Project Description:**

The purpose of the Proposed Action is to rehabilitate the Abenaki Tribal HQ Main Building at 100 Grand Avenue, Swanton, VT, to support community-based human services and the Abenaki tribal headquarters. The project includes roof replacement and reinforcement, energy retrofits, heating and cooling upgrades, ADA compliance improvements, walk-in cooling installation, masonry repointing, and other historic preservation efforts. These renovations will revitalize the facility, improve operational efficiency, and enhance the delivery of essential services to the community.

## Findings and Adoption of EA:

Based on the analysis presented in the 2024 EA, NBRC has determined that funding the renovation of the Abenaki Tribal HQ Main Building would not have a significant impact on the human or natural environment. The determination of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is consistent with what is presented in the 2024 EA and HUD's determination. An environmental impact statement will not be prepared.
